Reading/That Which Is Read

- Two Views of when TaNaKH was put together
 - TaNaKH was put together around 450 BCE. (*Talmud*)
 - TaNaKH was finalized between 200 BCE and 200 CE (*Modern Scholars*)
- The group of books were called Miqra not TaNaKH
 - Even though it was already divided into three parts of
 - Torah,
 - Nevi'im, and
 - Ketuvim
- Today in Modern Hebrew, TaNaKH and Miqra mean the same thing
- Today using the term "Miqra" is the same as using "Scriptures" or "Bible"
